

VACCINATION RECORDS

Ask your vet to send us your dog's vaccine records by emailing them to vaccines@petropolis.com. We won't be able to check your dog in without these in our system, so please be sure to contact your vet in advance.

REQUIRED VACCINES

- Rabies
- Bordetella
- DHLPP
- Canine Influenza (H3N2)

EMERGENCY CONTACT

Decide on an emergency contact. This contact is used only in emergencies or if you need someone other than yourself to pick your dog up at the end of their stay. If we have questions or need to make minor adjustments during your dog's stay, we will contact you directly.

FOOD

Pack your dog's usual food, and be sure to pack enough for the duration of their stay. We very much appreciate it if you bring your pet's food separated into pre-measured portions. If your pet is on a special diet, we will make sure to follow your instructions. If you don't wish to bring your dog's food, we will provide some.

MEDICATION

If your dog takes any medication, make sure to bring that and directions for proper dosage. We ask that you leave their medication in its original packaging (prescription bottles, etc.).

CREATURE COMFORTS

Pack a blanket, pillow or other soft item that smells like home. This will give your dog something familiar to snuggle with and make bedtime a little cozier. Also, feel free to bring your dog's favorite toys when you drop them off. We will put them in your pet's room. (All we ask is that you do not bring tennis balls or rope toys as they can be hazardous during unsupervised play. For safety reasons, we also do not allow any of our dogs to have rawhide treats or toys.)
